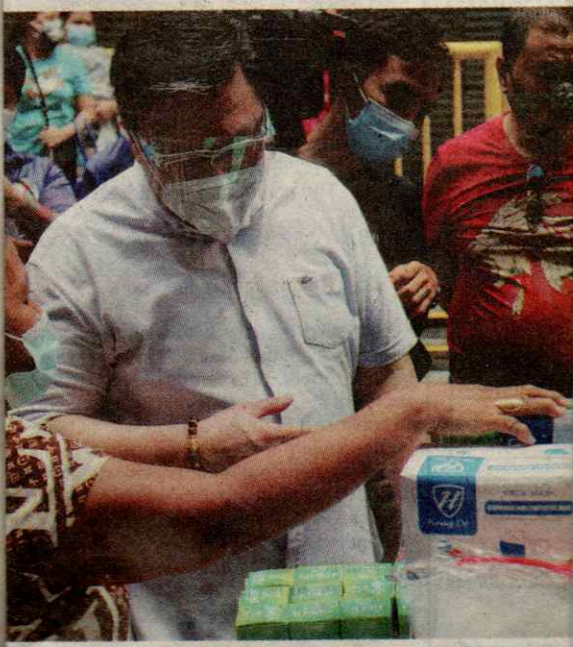

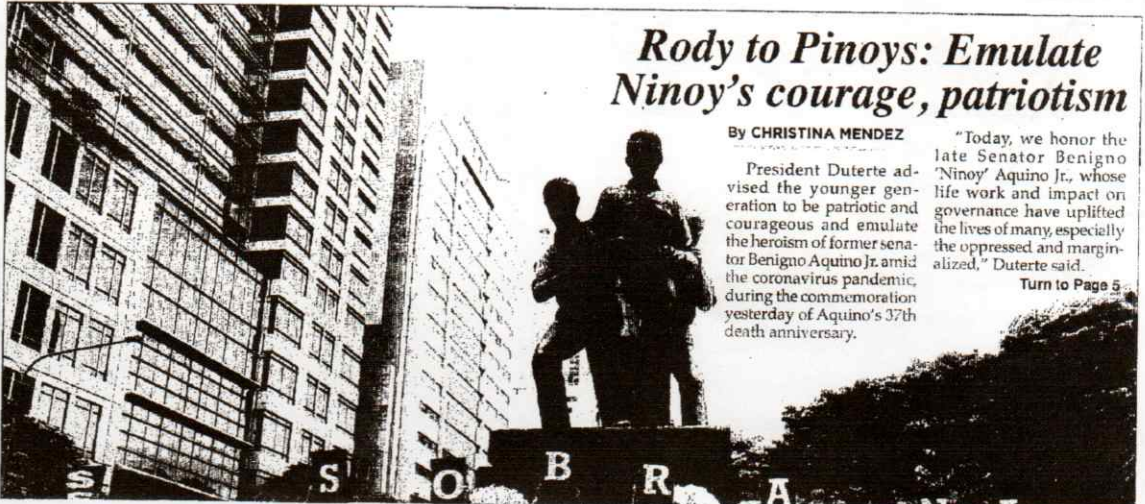

Rainy weekend seen due to LPA

More rains are expected over Northern and Central Luzon this weekend due to a low-pressure area, which was forecast to develop into a tropical depression last night or today.

As of 3 p.m. yesterday, the low-pressure area was spotted at 125 kilometers north northeast of Basco, Batanes, the Philippine Atmospheric, Geophysical and Astronomical Services Administration (PAGASA) said.

It was expected to develop into a tropical depression in the next 24 hours and will be locally named Igame, according to PAGASA weather forecaster Ariel Rojas.

Rojas said the brewing cyclone was expected to enhance the southwest monsoon, which will bring scattered rains over parts of Northern Luzon, particu-

larly Cordillera Administrative region and Cagayan Valley region, and Central Luzon until tomorrow.

"We warn the public of possible flooding and landslides because these areas have been experiencing rains in the past several days," he said.

He said the weather disturbance was likely to move north and was not expected to hit any part of the country.

It was forecast to exit the Philippine area of responsibility tonight or tomorrow morning.

In his one-page message commemorating Ninoy Aquino Day, the President stressed the importance of emulating Aquino's courage and patriotism that comes with one's discipline and social responsibility.

"As this important occasion is remembered during this time that we are facing a global public health crisis, may we emulate Ninoy's courage and patriotism so we may all be heroes through acts of discipline, goodwill and social responsibility," he said.

Duterte urged for the public's cooperation as this generation fights another form of challenge — the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic which has wrecked economies and the health situation around the globe.

In these trying times, Duterte also said those who have more in life should share their blessings with the less fortunate.

"I call on everyone to cooperate and work with the government so that we may keep ourselves, our families and our communities safe. May we also generously share our resources to those who have less in life during this trying times," he said.

Vice President Leni Robredo said yesterday that the assassination of Aquino 37 years ago should remind Filipinos to "speak truth to power" and believe that they "deserve better as people."

"We remember why he was killed: for speaking truth to power. For believing that we deserve better as a people. For hoping, and acting on that hope, and being brave enough to lay down his life for that hope," Robredo said in her message on the death anniversary of Aquino.

"Today, as we endure yet another dark night, we draw inspiration from Ninoy's story: from his courage, from his steadfast faith in our people, from his heroism," she said.

Robredo said Aquino's murder reminds Filipinos how we are all bound together even more tightly during times of oppression, suffering and crisis.

"Ninoy believed in a better future for Filipinos even when it was not easy," she said.

"Through long years of imprisonment, separation from his family, suffering and exile, he clung to the unshakable belief that the dark night would pass and dawn would break over the land he loved," Robredo said.

Several members of the August 21 Movement (ATOM) braved the rains yesterday morning and commemorated the death anniversary of Aquino in simple ceremonies at the tarmac of the Ninoy Aquino International Airport Terminal 1 that was named after the fallen hero.

The persons who offered flowers on the Aquino marker at the airport's departure area included Fernando Peña of the Chino Roces foundation, Chris Carreon of the group Spirit of Edsa, Jeoland Santos of ITI Eathsaver and a representative from the National Historical Commission.

He was shot dead by soldiers on Aug. 21, 1983 after he was accosted by troops shortly upon arrival at the then Manila International Airport on board a China Airlines flight from Taipei, Taiwan on his return flight after years of exile abroad.

Aquino, a vocal critic of the late dictator Ferdinand Marcos, came home to lead the political opposition against the dictatorship. ATOM through Cecille Alvarez, wife of former senator Heherson Alvarez, verbally requested the Manila International airport Authority to hold a simple ceremony with flower offerings and short speeches to commemorate the heroism of Aquino at 7:30 a.m. on a rainy Friday. — With Helen Flores, Rudy Santos

'Fight vs COVID starts at home'

Sen. Bong Co warned the public about being complacent against COVID-19 and advised everyone to remain vigilant despite recent developments in vaccine trials around the world. Philippine authorities also began relaxing some quarantine protocols, such as the recent shift to general community quarantine of many areas in the country, including Metro Manila.

According to the senator, prevention is still better than cure and the crucial fight against the virus starts in efforts at home and in com-

munities. "Let us remain vigilant since the fight is far from over. Let me remind everyone that your compliance with minimum health standards can save lives," Co said, emphasizing the need to be responsible citizens to help communities overcome the crisis.

In a press conference last Tuesday, World Health Organization Western Pacific regional director Dr. Takeshi Kasai, while expressing optimism about the speed in the development of COVID-19 vaccine, said he remains cau-

tious because "even they can really manage. Develop safe and effective vaccine, the production capacity would not really meet the demand coming from the entire world."

Recently, Russia announced it was the first country to develop a COVID-19 vaccine and offered to supply the Philippines with the vaccine. President Duterte, however, reminded Filipinos to continue complying with health protocols, such as physical distancing, wearing of mask, and proper cough etiquette, despite reports about vac-

cine availability. Co echoed the sentiments of the President and emphasized the importance of enhancing and properly implementing health protocols in communities to prevent the further spread of the virus while a vaccine is being developed.

"The important part of our fight against COVID-19 starts in us, in our homes, and in our communities. Through our cooperation, *matsakit sa kapwa*, and *bayanhan*, we can contribute to the global fight against COVID-19," Co said.
